Saturday April 18, 2015: Demo and Discussion.

April 19 & 20: Hands-On Workshops



TRENT BOSCH has captured the imagination of turners for some time now. While still relatively young (at least compared to the folks that usually turn up at our club meetings) Trent has amassed a lifetime of learning and growth in woodturning. He is one of the most sought after demonstrators working today.

He runs a very popular woodturning school from his studio in Fort Collins, Colorado and has developed and innovative line of woodturning tools.

His friendly presentation style makes him a joy to listen too, but don't be deceived by the laid back atmosphere. The demo day and classes will be chock-

full of great and tested information that turners of all skill levels can use.

SATURDAY DEMO:

Vessels and Surfaces: Techniques Trent uses in the creation of a hollow form and ways to make the surface outstanding! From textures to colors to sandblasting and beyond - making this much more than just a hollow form demo.

Sunburst platter: Trent turns a platter from green wood from start to finish and carves a sunburst pattern into the rim. Along the way he discusses drying techniques, getting the cleanest cut possible to minimize sanding and more.

Vessels of Illusion: Trent developed this technique and will discuss how it developed and why. This demonstration will include turning



the outer hollow form, carving the vessel, turning the insert, using wood bending to get the insert in the outer vessel and principals of wood bending for woodturners.


Decorative Utility Bowls: In this session Trent rough turns a bowl from green wood, discusses drying techniques including kiln drying and building your own kiln as well as very simple and basic techniques. He returns a dry bowl using specially ground tools to get as clean a cut as possible to cut down on sanding. He will



then take that bowl and discuss and use lots of different decorative techniques including: carving, bleaching, dying, painting, burning, sand blasting and surface textures.

Finding Your Own Voice: This is a slide show discussion. Trent will showcase the work of others who have connected with their work on a deeper level than just a nice piece of wood. He'll also look at their sources of inspiration. After the slide presentation will be an interactive discussion where we will discuss with participants how they could find their own voice.

Sculpting Wood Beyond the Lathe: In this demo Trent will show a tremendous amount of techniques and equipment for sculpting wood from aggressive tools like chainsaws and grinders to the finest of finishing and detailing tools.

SUNDAY WORKSHOP: Focused specifically on several smaller hollow forms with an emphasis on technique and process. This would give participants all the basic skills need to hollow proficiently.

MONDAY WORKSHOP: focused specifically on several smaller bowls and platters with an emphasis on technique and process. This would give participants all the basic skills needed to turn these objects proficiently.
